

## **AP Art Studio**

One Year: 10 Credits

### **Course Overview:**

This is a class in which you work with a teacher willing to supervise your development of the AP Studio portfolio. Although the portfolio can be completed in one year, we recommend taking the class for two years to allow appropriate time to develop the quality of the pieces required to pass the portfolio exam.

### **Applying for AP Art Studio:**

To be considered for the AP Art Studio class, a portfolio of student work must be submitted for the art department to evaluate by **Friday, February 18th** along with a cover letter that highlights art courses taken, relevant experiences and choice of portfolio to be pursued.

### **Prerequisites:**

A high school level course is required for the portfolio area; students who have taken an off-campus class must submit a letter of reference from their teacher.

### **Homework/Outside of Class Requirements:**

Students are expected to work about 8 hours a week outside of school to receive an A grade. We encourage students to submit this work to the College Board to receive college credit, but are not required to do so in order to receive credit for the class.
