

Chinese 4 Honors

Course Overview

Chinese 4 Honors is designed to teach students at a higher level of Chinese. Students will learn how to master complex sentence structure and write compositions. It aims to provide students with more advanced grammar, reading comprehension, expressions and communication skills.

This course is aligned to the California World Language Standards and built based on National World Language Standards.

Prerequisites

Completion of Chinese 3 with a grade of C or better or by evaluation. On UC/CSU Approved Course: "e"

Assessments

Evaluation is based on quizzes, exams, homework, oral presentations, class participation, essays and special projects.

- *Comprehension checks, both oral and in quiz format
- *Class performance
- *Special projects (with teacher guidance and approval)
- *Essays and journals
- *Final exam

Homework

Students are expected to have about 3 to 4 hours of independent practice and study for each week. Homework includes daily oral practice, reading and listening comprehension, vocabulary knowledge, and writing assignments etc. Special projects about Chinese language or culture event are required.
