

Spanish IV Honors

Course Overview

In Spanish IV Honors, students continue practicing and furthering their knowledge and skills in Spanish. Students learn how to master more complex structures such as the subjunctive. Through short films, class activities, games, songs, and literary readings students practice new vocabulary and structures. The class is mainly instructed in Spanish. This is a more demanding class than any previous Spanish classes. Students with a B or better in the class will be ready to take Sp. V, AP Language.

Prerequisites

A grade of a C in Sp. III is required, a B is recommended, or teacher's approval.

Tests

Students take chapter exams that include short, multiple-choice, and fill in the blank answers. There are also oral tests and short compositions. The final for each semester is comprehensive.

Homework

Students are expected to do 3 to 4 hours of homework/week in average. This includes preparation for presentations and composition rewrites.
